

# Chore Chart

Print both of these sheets on cardstock paper if possible.

The first sheet is what you will post in your home.

The second sheet is where you will list all the chores your children need to do.

After you print off the second sheet, cut on the solid line so you have many squares,  
each with a chore listed on it.

Put poster tack or a removable sticky substance to the back of each square.

Post each square next to a child's name on the first chart.

(You probably won't need all of the squares)

All the chores your child needs to complete for the day are now listed next to their name.

As they complete a chore they can remove that square and put it

at the bottom of the chart.

You can look at the chart at any point during the day and see if your child

has completed his required tasks.
